1. CALL TO ORDER: @ 5:30pm by Mayor

4. PERSONS BEFORE COUNCIL & COMMUNICATIONS FROM MAYOR: Fireworks displays not presented by organizations with state permits were of concern to several residents and businesses in Bath. A review of the Town ordinance and State statute was requested. The matter was referred to the Ordinance Committee. The Mayor presented for discussion Council committee assignments and appointments for the new term beginning July 1, 2019 (see attached).

Discussion was held concerning the lack of painted crosswalks on Washington Street (Rt. 522) through the Bath. The Mayor clarified that this issue is under the discretion of the WV DOH and that he and the Council are sympathetic to concerns. Recorder Webster suggested bringing back pedestrian crosswalk signs. The matter was referred to the Public Safety Committee.

The new owners of 347 N. Washington Street have requested that this property be annexed into the Town of Bath corporate limits. The matter was referred to the Ordinance and Annexation Committees.
