- 3. REVIEW OF MINUTES: Meeting minutes of December 17, 2019 were approved by Common Consent.
- 4. COMMUNICATIONS FROM MAYOR: The Mayor reported that the holiday events and season had gone well and Bath is looking forward to an active and positive 2020.

- 1. BATH DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY: The next meeting is January 8, 2020.
- 2. PARKS & REC: The next meeting is December 18th at the Courthouse.
- 3. PLANNING COMMISSION: No report at this time.
- 4. RAIL/TRAIL: The next meeting will be January 22, 2020.
- 5. STREETSCAPE: A letter requesting a project calendar will be sent and copied to our State representatives.
- 6. TRAIN DEPOT: The project must be rebid due to WVDOH timing issues.
- 7. LANDMARK COMMISSION: The next meeting is January 28, 2020. A potential appointee applicant is expected to attend the next Council meeting.
- 8. CLERK/RECORDER REPORT: Recorder Webster reported on the Morgan County Economic Development Marc train stop project undertaking. She presented the MCEDA Resolution and will create a similar resolution for Bath Council consideration.
