- 1. CALL TO ORDER: @ 5:30pm by Mayor electronically via Zoom
- 2. ROLLCALL: Scott Merki (X) Susan Webster (X) Chris Chapman (X) Rose Jackson (X) Elizabeth Skinner (X) John Bohrer (X) Rick Weber (X) Quorum present.
- 3. REVIEW OF MINUTES: Meeting minutes of March 17, 2020 were approved by Common Consent.
- 4. PERSONS BEFORE COUNCIL: None at this time.
- 5. COMMUNICATIONS FROM MAYOR: The Mayor expressed his continuing concern with the coronavirus pandemic. The Town is adhering to the Executive Order from Gov. Justice on health and safety guidelines. There is much concern for the Town's business community. The Mayor announced known public event cancellations.

The HUD Fair Housing Month Proclamation was presented (see attached).

The 2020 Arbor Day Proclamation was presented (see attached).

The Mayor shared a request that the Town allow banners to be placed in businesses and public buildings recognizing Berkeley Springs High School Senior spring athletes who will not be able to participate in their sports due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Recorder Webster suggested that since the Town has no control over what private businesses or other public entities display in support of these athletes that the Town of Bath support these students in whatever way possible. This was approved by Common Consent.

- 1. BATH DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY: President Cindy Bodin presented the Authority's Treasurer's report and recent progress. The Authority's next meeting is May 6th. She expects to present new appointees for consideration at the Town's next regular meeting.

- 4. RAIL/TRAIL: Committee member Pete Brown reported that the Mayor has communicated with Gary Graley of the WV DOH.
