

TOWN OF BATH SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

The purpose of this Special Meeting of Council is to have discussion concerning amending Chapter 42 Historic Preservation of the Town of Bath Code to include permitting the Bath Historic Landmark Commission to issue Certificates of Appropriateness as the Commission has proposed.

The Mayor turned the proceedings over to the meeting facilitator, Sally Marshall.


Ms. Marshall explained the rules under which the meeting would be conducted. David Abruzzi, representing the Bath Historic Landmark Commission, gave an introduction and timeline of the amendment, proposed ordinance and resurvey of the Bath Historic District which would be subject to the granting of Certificates of Appropriateness. Attached are documents and proposed ordinance amendment.

Ms. Marshall conducted the order of persons to speak and time period allowed. Over seventy (70) attendees were present (see attached sign in sheet). More than twenty (20) of those present requested and were permitted to speak. The public was also invited to email comments to Town Hall.


