

SPECIAL ORDINANCE 94-4

An Ordinance Repealing and Amending Certain Sections and Provisions of Title 12, Chapter 2, of The Code of the Town of Bath, West Virginia.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BATH THAT TITLE 12, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 12-202, "DUTIES OF THE BUILDING INSPECTOR", IS HEREBY REPEALED AND THAT SAID TITLE, CHAPTER AND SECTION BE MODIFIED AND AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS;

Section 12-202 Duties of the Building Inspector

The Building Inspector shall examine all building permit applications submitted to the Council to determine if the work to be completed meets with accepted standards and practices prevailing in the community. The provisions of the "Basic Building Code" (BOCA) of the 1990 edition as amended from time to time, and published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, INC., may be considered as standard and acceptable practice. *RAF*

The Building Inspector may examine premises for which permits have been issued to see that an applicant is complying with provisions of the permit application and that work is prosecuted safely.
