

ORDINANCE 2002-04

Replacing Special Ordinance 98-02

The Town of Bath Council Standing Committees as of July 1, 2002 are as follows:

FINANCE

The Finance committee will oversee financial matters involving the Town of Bath. Such items shall include, but not limited to budget, revenue, expenses, etc., as well as other financial matters to come before council.

ORDINANCE

The Ordinance committee will be responsible for the establishment of and or any changes to existing Town of Bath Ordinances. This committee will prepare and submit in writing proposed ordinances before the council for a 1st and 2nd reading.

WATER WORKS

The Water Works committee will provide oversight on the operations of the Berkeley Springs Water Works.

PUBLIC WORKS

The Public Works Committee will provide oversight in matters having to do with the Town of Bath Streets, Solid Waste, etc.

PUBLIC SAFETY

The Public Safety Committee will provide oversight to the Town of Bath / Berkeley Springs Police Department. The Mayor's role as Police Commissioner shall remain unchanged by this ordinance. This committee will also serve as a liaison to the Berkeley Springs Volunteer Fire Department and report to Council.

CEMETERY

The Cemetery Committee will provide oversight on matters involving the Greenway Cemetery

The Mayor nor any member of the Town Council may serve as Chair of more than one committee, unless waived by a motion, seconded and at least four members of the Town Council. The Mayor and Council may serve on more than one committee.

The Mayor may appoint Ad hoc committees as deemed necessary and relevant.

This Ordinance supersedes all previous ordinances relating to the subjects contained herein.
