

# ORDINANCE 2002-05

## IMMOBILIZATION OF CERTAIN VEHICLES


When any Police Officer or Police Department employee of the Town of Bath finds on a city street a vehicle which as in the past been cited for a traffic violation including overtime parking violation and which violations has not been disposed of in the Police court in accordance with the Ordinance pertaining thereto, or which vehicle is in violation of the provisions of this chapter, and the City Police Officer or Police Department employee deems it necessary, in order to enforce such provisions, that an immobilizer be used, then such City Police Officer or Police Department employee may immobilize such vehicle by installing or attaching a device thereto until the owner or driver thereof has satisfied any existing and post violations in accordance with Ordinance pertaining thereto.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon the date of passage.
