ORDINANCE 2006-04

(AN ORDINANCE MAKING MERCER STREET ONE WAY NORTH TO SOUTH
FROM FAIRFAX STREET TO MARTINSBURG ROAD (STATE ROUTE 9E))

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BATH, MORGAN
COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

A special ordinance enacted by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Bath establishing Mercer Street from its intersection at Fairfax Street to its intersection at Martinsburg Road (State Route 9E) to be one way in a North to South traffic flow direction. Legal parking of vehicles on said portion of Mercer Street shall be established by the Berkeley Springs Police Department.

Penalties:

Drivers in violation of this ordinance may be cited in accordance with the West Virginia State Law or Town of Bath ordinance. The Berkeley Springs Police Department may cause vehicles parked in violation of this ordinance to be towed away and impounded at the owner's expense.

The Town of Bath shall recover any fees associated with the collection of said penalties.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon 2nd Reading and approval of the Town of Bath Council, once appropriate signage is in place.
