

CASE STUDY: Green Infrastructure implemented into Streetscape in Bath, WV (Berkeley Springs)

In 2016, with support from the Chesapeake Bay Trust and other sources, the third



phase of streetscape construction incorporated green infrastructure into the design for the first time. Silva Cells under pervious pavers with several planter boxes were installed along the town's main street (Washington St.). Located at the town square, this project serves as a visual and functional component to Bath's commitment to green infrastructure. During construction, local citizens and visitors were able to see the construction as it progressed, while the local press published weekly project updates and information. An educational display of the project is widely viewed and serves as an example of future Streetscapes and other community projects.
