- 4. Comprehensive Plan Development Discussion
 - a. Weekly Working Group Update:

Public Safety: Discussion with Police Chief Carper (comments & perspective)

- Fire & EMS comments should come from the Fire Chief
- Currently there is no code enforcement (e.g. building, 30-day parking limit, etc)
- The best time to begin enforcement of codes that have not been enforced such as the 30day parking rule is after the street has been improved (e.g. paving Wilkes St.)
- Clean-up of Bad Properties
 - ✓ Owner engagement & negotiations, private buyout
 - ✓ Appeal to higher authorities (county, state)
- Community policing should be included in the plan. Lack of officers impact community policing.
- Replacement for the Biking & Skate Boarding park is desirable Concern was based on conversations with youth & teens.
 (Biser St, David Henry park worth consideration)
- Police dept needs an Office Administrator to improve dept effectiveness.
- The town-of-bath police dept can exercise traffic enforcement any where with the town limits (e.g. Jake Brake usage etc)
- Applying for WV Grants should be considered (e.g. Seat Belt / Sleepy Driver)
- City Magistrate is needed to for follow-up with regards to enforcement (Warrants)
 Scofflaw offenders should be reviewed periodically (e.g. 6 months).
- Use of K9's for drug enforcement is more expensive than value provided.
 (required coordination, loss officer time while supporting K9 actives)
- Dug Interdiction Programs should be considered.
- Public Events support
 - ✓ Use of volunteers introduces a risk (e.g. volunteer safety, liability)
 - ✓ Parking needs to be coordinated (Booting an option)
- Police dept is capable of conducting Investigations & Serving Warrants.

 - Finishing the floors were completed for \$1,800 by Shenandoah Flooring.
 - Sponsor Funding came from CNB \$900, Rotary Club \$100
