- 4. Comprehensive Plan Development Discussion
 - a. Weekly Working Group Update:

The working group is working on a draft version of "Interim Proposal on Representation at Stakeholder Forums and Committee Reporting".

- * Susan: Supported the effort by noting that the Town-of-Bath form of government is a "Weak Mayor" system, which puts a great deal of governance control on the members of Town-Council. The proposal calls out he need for town council's active representation on the standing committees.
- b. Discussion with Bath Development Authority (BDA) representative (Alisa Stine)
 - * Susan: Noted that Development Authority role is spelled out in WV-Code 7-12-7.
 - * Lisa: Supported the idea of having a Goal List spelled out in the Comprehensive Plan.
 - * Lisa: Supporting Tourist Industry should be major goal.
 - * Lisa: The lack of Building Supply is a concern, limiting new business formation.
 - Idol & Abandon buildings is a further complication
 - * Lisa: Developing youth skills is desirable
 - * Lisa: Identifying the needed services to support the Lotus Rehab center is desirable but BDA does not have a Lotus contact or relationship.
 - * Lisa: Is not supportive of a common community calendar because of logistic challenges.
 - * Lisa: A Town Analysis (or Survey) is not needed.
 - * Lisa: Expressed concern about labor availability:
 - Affordable Housing,
 - Training/Education
 - * Lisa: West Virginia Main Street / ONTRAC Program should be evaluated (WVCAD Community Advancement & Development a division of WV Dept of Economic Development https://WVCad.Org)
 - * Lisa/Larry: Discussed the need for new businesses outreach to improve local assimilation. The greatest challenge considered to be the initial contact.
