

Deck the Meters

2024 Rules & Regulations

Meter decorations should be no taller than 72" and no more than 36" in diameter. The meters measure 52" tall and the meter heads are approximately 12" x 12" x 8". Participants are encouraged to visit their assigned meter before designing and decorating.

*In order to accommodate the Bath Christmas Market, not all Parking Meters will be available for decorations this year. *

PLEASE DO NOT WRAP THE METER HEAD. The meter head may be covered but NOT wrapped in anything that would cause condensation. Or, please provide for an air gap around the meter head and air circulation around the meter in your design. All parking at the meters will be FREE while they are decorated.

Water, weather, and wind-proof materials are strongly suggested; do not attach anything of value. Meter decorations must be secure so that they do not blow around or get knocked over easily.

No tape, adhesives or paint may be used directly on the parking meter or pole. Zip ties are encouraged. No painting on or around the sidewalk or street.

Decorations may not impede pedestrian sidewalk, street travel or parking in spaces.

Participants are responsible for maintaining their meter throughout the entire project period and are expected to check on their meters regularly and to repair any damages to the decorations. If we notice that the decorations on the meter are falling apart/blowing away, you will be notified to remove them. If you do not, we will confiscate them.

The Town of Bath is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged decorations and reserve the right to remove decorations they deem inappropriate. All participants are expected to display family-friendly décor. No political messages please.

The Town of Bath will assign meters. Participants must only use their assigned meter. Any participants who decorate a meter not assigned to them will have the decorations removed and forfeits the opportunity to participate in future projects.

Reminder: Business owners are not to use the parking spaces. The Town allows the FREE parking to promote tourists to come into our Town and shop.

IMPORTANT DATES:

Meter decorating may begin on, Friday, November 29, 2024.

All meter decorations must be in place by Saturday, December 7, 2024.

ALL DECORATIONS MUST BE REMOVED BY FRIDAY, DECEMBER 27TH.

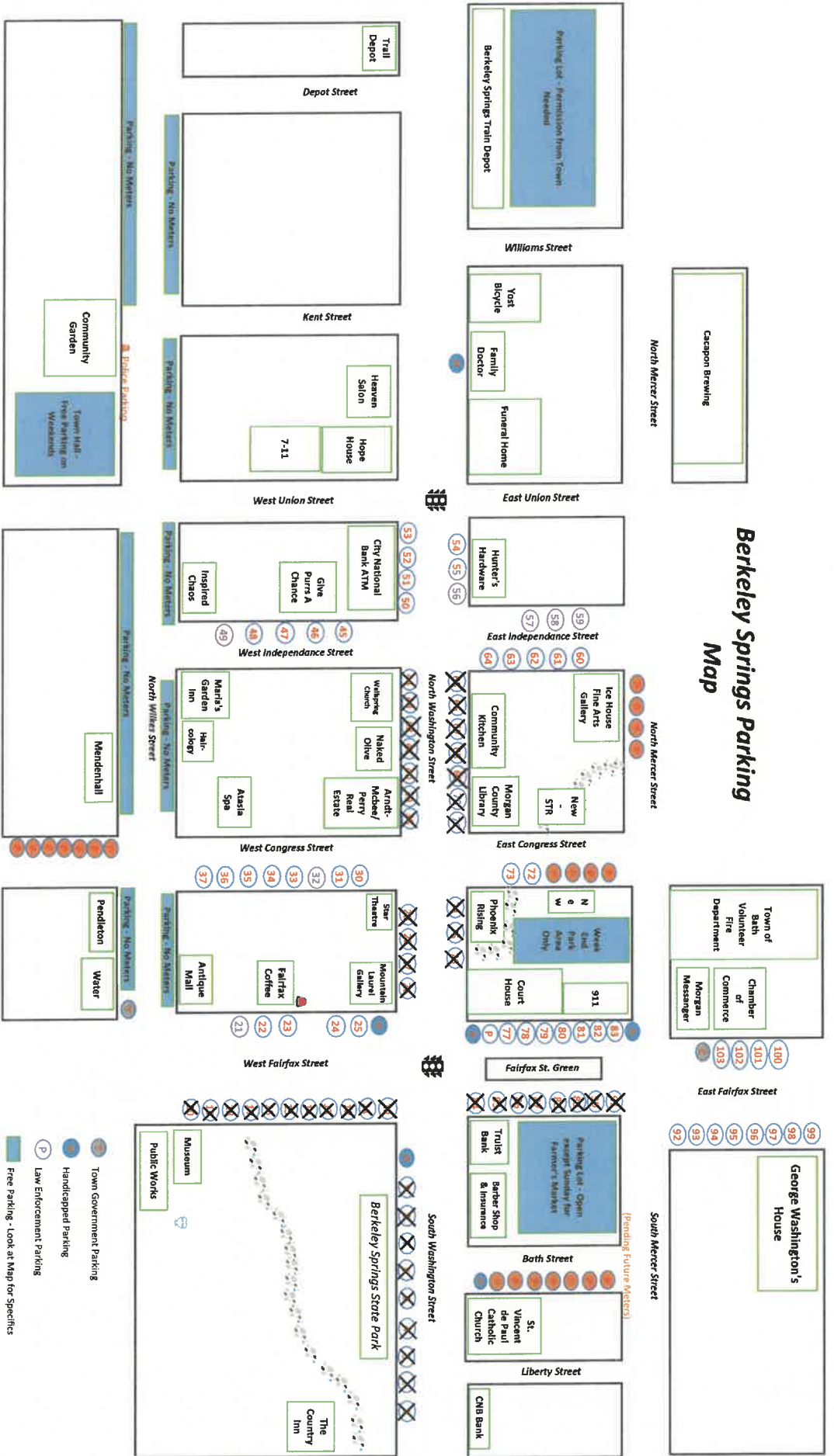
